Happy New Year!

Many in the astrological field are putting a great deal of focus on the year 2020 and, yes, there will be many important and intense changes in 2020, but let's not forget 2019! It's time to be in the now and to pay attention to what this year holds for us, both globally and personally.

We started 2019 with a partial solar eclipse on January 6th. We can expect a total lunar eclipse on January 21st. Total eclipses are always more powerful than partial eclipses. This year there will be three eclipse seasons. These eclipses will bring many changes and upsets dealing with royalty, weather, finances, people and nature. We can also expect many changes involving women and surprises in the White House. It seems to me that 2019 has much to get our attention.

Another eclipse date is July 2nd and this one will last 4 minutes and 33 seconds, the longest one in six years, and includes the possibility of earthquakes in the Oklahoma region. On December 26th there will be an annular solar eclipse over Saudi Arabia, India and Southeast Asia. This could impact the stock markets as we head into 2020 as Jupiter will cross the ecliptic, from north to south, which in the past, activated a market turn down or a straightforward crash. Caution is advised in investments. There are currently three planets: Jupiter, Saturn and Neptune transiting the Earth, all of them in their own signs, i.e., Jupiter rules Sagittarius, Saturn rules Capricorn and Neptune rules Pisces. When planets are in their own signs they are very powerful as it is the full expression of that planet. There are two planets changing signs: Chiron is moving from Pisces to Aries and Uranus is moving from Aries into Taurus. There will be great energy around healing (Chiron in Aries) and money, banks and finances will experience sudden changes (Uranus in Taurus). We are seeking the bigger picture of life (Sagittarius); we must use our discipline (Capricorn) and be compassionate (Pisces) if we are to create positive change, globally and personally.

What does all of this mean for you and me? Where do these eclipses fall in your astrological chart? 2019 is a year to examine where we are in our lives; how do we handle challenging times and yet still enjoy our lives? Having your astrological chart is of great value as times are intense and great changes are occurring. What is your life purpose? Are you living it?
